Rosemary passed away Monday, August 17, 2020 at the Heritage of Bel Air Nursing Home in Norfolk. Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements.

Born Nov. 29, 1944, in Norfolk, Rosemary was the daughter of Arthur and Ida (Jirovec) Petersen and was the middle of seven children. She graduated from Stanton High School in 1963.

She married Jack Peyton on Dec. 5, 1965, at Colorado Springs, Colo.

Rosemary formerly lived in Trenton, Mo., and Tucson, Ariz., before moving back to Stanton. Upon returning to Stanton, she managed Casey's for many years and also worked at Emmett's Food Town.

She was a member of St. Peter's Catholic Church in Stanton.

Rosemary was predeceased by her spouse, Jack Elliott Peyton, on May 14, 1994; her parents; and her brother, Jon Petersen.

Survivors include her sons, Steve (Heather) Peyton of Story City, Iowa, and Matt Peyton of Stanton; her three grandchildren, Ashley, Haley and Aaron;
