NORFOLK — Services for Samuel C. Harrison, 52, of Hawarden, Iowa, will be at 11 a.m. Thursday at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Norfolk with the Rev. Dan Andrews officiating. Military rites will be by American Legion Post 16, VFW Post 1644 and the U.S. Navy Honors Guard. Inurnment will be at a later date. Visitation will be 5-8 p.m. Wednesday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk with a rosary at 8 p.m. He died Saturday, Dec. 5, 2015, at the Faith Regional Health Services in Norfolk.

The son of Lawrence “Todd” and Janet Y. (Hass) Harrison was born Dec. 19, 1962, in Norfolk. Sam grew up in Stanton and Norfolk, where he loved playing baseball and was a member of the FFA while he attended Norfolk High School. He soon joined the U.S. Navy, serving from May 7, 1985 to May 5, 1989.

After his honorable discharge, he worked as a boiler operator in the ethanol plant in Columbus. Sam then worked in maintenance at Faith Regional Health Services, and the last 15 years at the Siouxland Energy Co-op in Sioux Center, Iowa, while residing in Hawarden. Sam was member of the American Legion Two Oaks Post 254 in Hawarden. He enjoyed raising Angus Cattle and the company of his Dachshund Dogs.

He was a lifetime fan of the Nebraska Cornhuskers and the Chicago Bears.
