After marriage, Sandy and Dave lived in Wisner, NE then moved to Winter, S.D., for Dave’s work as head mechanic at a car dealership. They moved to Norfolk and Sandy worked at Mary’s Café in Norfolk and then later Just A Buck. She enjoyed going to auctions and thrifting, she loved to craft and took special pride in creating money art items such as stock cars, graduation hats and even motorcycles. She loved animals and had three cats up until her

passing. She was a member at Christ Lutheran Church, Norfolk, and a former Mt. Olive Lutheran Church member before marriage.

Survivors include her daughter Kandi (Bill) Kralik of Norfolk and their daughters Kali and Karli. She was preceded in death by her spouse Dave on March 3, 1998, infant daughter Brandi in 1977, and parents Erwin and Arvilla.
