He attended Bel-Air Elementary School, graduated from Norfolk High School in 1990 and graduated from Northeast Community College with a degree as an electronics technician in 1996.

Scott grew up in Norfolk. He later moved to Lincoln where he worked in his field as a electronics technician for several years. Due to an injury he was unable to keep working in this field, at which time he began taking classes in business management. Scott was most proud and passionate about anything and everything involving his son Jordan. They shared the love of football, which is what you could find them enjoying together nearly every Saturday and Sunday throughout the season and talking about and preparing for it in the off season. He enlisted in the National Guard as an infantryman in 1990, served for six years and was honorably discharged in 1996. He was married to Sonia Koehler on May 21, 1994, at Zion Lutheran Church, Pierce. They divorced in 2000. Survivors include son Jordan Brus of Lincoln, brother Joe and wife
