



## Shawn T. McCrady

February 22, 1967 - August 6, 2023

NORFOLK – A private celebration of life service for Shawn T. McCrady, 56, of Norfolk will be held for just family and friends at a later date. Shawn passed away on Sunday, August 6, 2023, surrounded by his family, due to a hard-fought battle of Metastatic Pancreatic Cancer diagnosed in December of 2022. Shawn and family gained confidence after undergoing aggressive chemo treatments until June when the chemo stopped working. Stonacek Funeral Chapel is in charge of the arrangements.

Shawn was born on February 22, 1967 in Norfolk to Cheryl Ann (McCrady) Fisher. He attended grade school in Pierce and graduated from Hastings High School. He worked as a Diesel Mechanic until diagnosed with cancer.

Shawn enjoyed going to church and loved God. Shawn fought to stay alive until he was able to meet the 2 newest grandsons', one born in May and the other born 4 days before he passed away.

Survivors include his wife Kimberly McCrady of Norfolk, children Josh Dittmer of Fairfield, NE, Mariah (Dominic) Tunink, Brendan McCrady, Hannah (Jon) Malec, Breyton McCrady all from Hastings, 5 grandsons father/mother-in-law Keith and Debra Dudley of Roseland, NE, and many friends whom he treated and welcomed as extended family.
