PIERCE – Funeral service for Sheri L. Lambrecht, 45 of Norfolk will be held at 10:30 a.m. Saturday, January 27, 2024 at Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce, Nebraska. Visitation will be 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Friday, January 26, 2024 at Zion Lutheran Church, Pierce. Sheri passed away on Monday, January 22, 2024 at her residence in Norfolk, Nebraska. Stonacek Memorial Chapel in Pierce is in charge of arrangements.

Sheri was born on August 22, 1978 to Douglas and Janet (Droescher) Lambrecht. She was baptized on September 10, 1978 at Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce, Nebraska and later confirmed on April 26, 1992 also at Zion Lutheran Church. She grew up on the family farm west of Pierce and attended Zion Lutheran School in Pierce until the eighth grade and graduated from Pierce High School in 1996. While growing up she enjoyed playing A.Y.S.O. soccer, softball, basketball, volleyball and playing in the band. Sheri then attended Northeast Community College for two years before transferring to the University of Nebraska at Kearney for a year and graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in Social Work from Wayne State College in 2000. After college she went to work at a Group Home in Columbus where she worked for several years as a social worker. Sheri married Jack Wragge in 2000 and the couple later divorced. She then went to work at Walmart as a cashier and in

September 2016 went to work as a waitress at the Granary in Norfolk. She enjoyed playing cards, traveling with her mom, watching movies and sports, especially Husker sports, Oregon Ducks and the Philadelphia Eagles. She was a big supporter of her nieces and nephews in all of their activities.

She is survived by her father Doug Lambrecht of Pierce, brother Scott (Bridget) Lambrecht of Pierce, nieces and nephews; Emily (David) Cartier, Grant Lambrecht, Brayden Lambrecht, Raegen Lambrecht and Taylor Lambrecht.

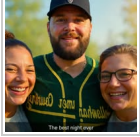
