The daughter of Leonard and Gertrude (Ament) Hochhalter was born Dec. 12, 1937, in Yankton. She attended Sacred Heart School in Yankton. Shirley worked as a nurse aid at Sacred Heart Hospital in Yankton until 1969 when she began working for Dale Electronics in Norfolk. She married Kenneth Elkins on March 19, 1971, in Valentine. After marriage, Shirley and Ken moved to Norfolk in 1971. Shirley and Ken had two daughters and eventually made their home in Hoskins. After retiring from Dale Electronics in 1990, Shirley was a volunteer at the American Red Cross and local Food Pantry. Shirley was also a volunteer as an EMT for the Hoskins Rescue Unit. Shirley suffered from a stroke in 2002 but remained in her home until July 2010, when she made her home at Countryside Home in Madison. Shirley enjoyed fishing, going to garage sales and spending time with her grandchildren. She was a past member of Sacred Heart Parish in Yankton. Survivors include her husband, Ken Elkins of Hoskins; two daughters, Jody Elkins of Sioux Falls, S.D., and Teresa Weidenback of Madison; grandsons Cody Suckstorf and Jordan Suckstorf, both of Norfolk; a granddaughter, Jade Elkins of Norfolk; a great-granddaughter, Aylah; two brothers, Duane Hochhalter of Shoreview, Minn., and Ray Hochhalter of
