PIERCE — Services for Sylvia A. Ahlman, 71, of Pierce will be at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday at Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce. The Rev. Gordon Bruce and Vicar Jonathan Torreson will officiate with burial in Prospect View Cemetery in Pierce. Visitation will be 4-7 p.m. Tuesday at Stonacek Memorial Chapel in Pierce. Sylvia Ann Ahlman died Friday, Sept. 16, 2016, at Premier Estates of Pierce, formerly Pierce Manor, where she had been a resident since August of 2005. Sylvia was born on March 24, 1945, in Norfolk to Delbert and Marjorie (Hausmann) Ahlman. She grew up on the family farm northeast of Pierce. She attended District 46, St. John's Lutheran Grade School and Zion Lutheran Grade School through the eighth grade. She was baptized on April 15, 1945, at Zion Lutheran Church by the Rev. M.F. Scheips and confirmed on March 22, 1959, by the Rev. Robert Harms. Sylvia enjoyed singing, dancing, playing bingo, watching Nebraska football and especially spending time with family. She was a volunteer worker at the Pierce Manor from January 1987 through the early part of 2005. She received the Community Service Award in 1992 from the Pierce Jaycees for her volunteer work. Her volunteer work included visiting with residents, taking them outdoors, serving them treats, reminding residents of daily activities and taking them to activities. She received much satisfaction from working there. As a resident, she was voted Sweetheart Queen on Valentine's Day one year. She was resident council president one term, and she was also a member of a weekly prayer group. Sylvia is survived by three sisters and their spouses, Sandra and Bill Buckendahl of Pierce,

Sherry and George Bradley of Randolph and Sheila and Richard Meyer of Kearney. Nieces and nephews include Chad (Sarah) Buckendahl of Las Vegas, Nev., Brice (Julie) Buckendahl of Pierce, Stephanie Noonan of Omaha, Christopher (Laura) Bradley of Santa Ana, Calif., Nicholas (Erin) Bradley of Waterloo, Aaron (Jessie) Meyer of Chandler, Ariz., Lane (Laura) Meyer of Commerce City, Colo., and Cole (Jackie) Meyer of Lincoln.
