He graduated from Cathedral Prep High School in Erie in 1946. He married Maxine Jeanette Thompson on Aug. 19, 1949. His military career was 27 years. It started in Denver, Colo., and he served one tour in Japan, two tours in Korea and one tour in Germany. He was Sergeant Major of the 21st. Corp. at Fort Indiantown Gap in Annville, Penn. He received multiple commendations for exemplary service. They moved to Pierce in 1972. After retirement he attended Northeast Community College and taught math in the utility lineman department for 19 years. He was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Pierce, Pierce EMTs, Boy Scout Leader and was active with the Pierce Senior Center and American Legion. They enjoyed camping, and he was a motorcycle enthusiast. Terence enjoyed spending his winters in Mesa, where he was active at the Senior Center there, as well as the Mesa Police Department and doing charitable work at the center for abused women,

the local orphanage and the V.A. Terence was a devoted husband, father, grandfather and great grandfather. He will be missed by all whose lives he touched. Survivors include his wife, Maxine Reagan; five children, Teralyn and husband David Mailey of Palmyra, Penn., Kevin and wife Marilyn Reagan of Pierce, Mark and wife Charlotte Reagan of Pierce, Tracey and husband Dan Campbell of Albia, Iowa, Matthew Reagan of El Mirage, Ariz.; grandchildren, Travis and wife Tanya Reagan, Justin Reagan, Jennifer Duchene, Brandon Reagan, Nichole Reagan, Christopher Reagan, Michael Oatman and William Oatman; great-grandchildren, Leah Reagan, Logan Reagan, Autumn Reagan, Reese Reagan, Ryder Schmoll, Emma Dietz; and a sister, Carol Johnson of Erie.
