Terry Jean Hamilton was born on July 18, 1948 to Delbert and Shirley Hamilton of Plainview, NE and was baptized at the Congregational Church. She graduated from Plainview High School in 1966, Wayne State College in 1969, and the University of Wyoming with a Masters in 1972 and Ph.D. in 1974 at age 25.

Terry taught 4th grade in Bancroft and Bradshaw, NE, was a school counselor in Lander, WY, was director of a dropout prevention program in Norfolk Public Schools, and then started private practice part-time to be at home with her children when they were born and until they entered school. She then taught at NECC followed by 23 years as a professor at WSC, retiring in 2013.

Terry is survived by her children, Sara and Benjamin Wingett and her granddaughter Aneira. Also surviving her are her sisters Diane Hoffman, Beth Vail, and Alice and husband Dave Dingle and her brother Gene and wife Michele Hamilton. She is also survived by nieces, nephews and friends.

Terry was preceded in death by her parents, brother Steven, and her niece, Jennifer Hoffman.
