He attended District 87 grade school, graduated from Norfolk Senior High School in 1969, attended Norfolk Junior College and graduated from Wayne State College in 1973. After college, he managed Nixon Feed Store from 1973 to 1977, then was a truck driver for Skelgas from 1977 to 1980. He was then district sales manager for Fontanelle Hybrid from 1980 to 2013. He was a member of the Battle Creek Wrestling Club, 4-H Horse Leader, was a founding member of the BC Roping Club, loved hunting with his dogs, Katie and Spud, and enjoyed horseback riding and team roping with his children, Mary Beth and Jesse, and his many friends. He was a present member of Mount Olive Church in Norfolk and a past member of St. John Lutheran Church in Battle Creek. Survivors are his wife, Nadine Peters, of Norfolk; one daughter, Mary Beth and Aric Butterfield of Plattsmouth; one son, Jesse Peters of Norfolk; one brother, Randy and Jule Peters of Norfolk; two sisters, Kim Nelson of Norfolk and Cindy and Mike

Reynoldson of Norfolk; many nieces, nephews, great-nieces and great-nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents, Leland and Lucille (Doerr) Peters, and one sister, Kathy Peters.
