NORFOLK -- Tim Gale Adams, age 77, of Norfolk, passed away June 21, 2015 at his residence. A Memorial Service will be held at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel at 11:00 a.m., Tuesday, June 30, 2015 with Mrs. Doris Markland officiating. A private family inurnment will follow at a later date. Tim was born in Newton, Iowa to L.E. (Barney) and Helene (Ainsworth) Adams on February 1, 1938. He was educated in the Norfolk Public Schools and graduated from the University of Nebraska in 1963 with a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration.

He married Sharon L. Timperley on June 21, 1959, and to this union were born two children, Tod and Tori.

In 1965, Tim and the family settled in Norfolk, where he was an accountant for Midwestern Beef Inc. and then later became General Manager. Later, in addition to accounting services, he managed the Norfolk Country Inn for a number of years before retirement.

Tim is survived by his wife Sharon Adams of Norfolk, son Tod and wife Julie Adams of Norfolk, daughter Tori and husband Chris Stratman of Wahoo, grandchildren Melanie and Hilary Adams, Rachel and Ethan Stratman, nephew David J. Adams of San Antonio, TX.

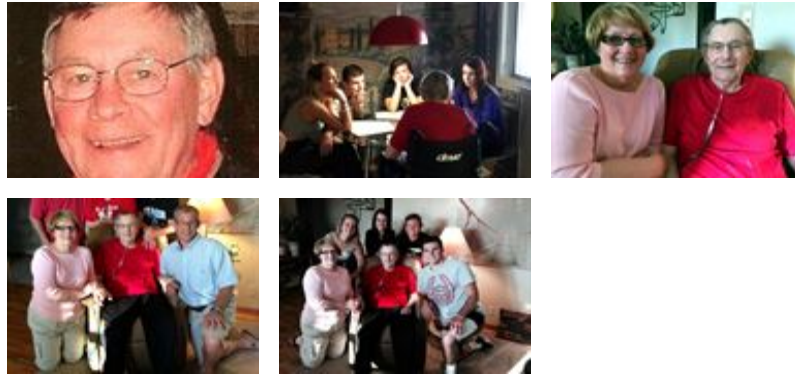
