HOSKINS – Funeral service for Tom J. Brockmann, 59, of Hoskins will be held at 10:30 a.m., Monday, October 21, 2019 at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Norfolk with Pastor Lee Weander officiating. Interment will be at the Hoskins City Cemetery, Hoskins. Visitation will be held 4:00-7:00 p.m., Sunday, at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Tom passed away Monday, October 14, 2019 of an apparent heart attack while elk hunting in the Uncompahgre National Forest in Colorado. Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements.

Tom was born on November 17, 1959 in West Point, NE to Melburn and Marian (Ludwig) Brockman. He attended elementary school and was confirmed at Immanuel Lutheran Church in rural Beemer, NE. In 1978, he graduated from West Point High School. After graduation, he moved to Houston, Texas where met Lorna King. The two married on April 12th, 1986 at Grace United Methodist Church in Correctionville, IA. The couple returned to Nebraska and had two children, Travis and Jared.

Tom graduated from Northeast Community College in 1992 with an Associates of Science Degree in HVAC. For many years, he worked for Volkman Plumbing and Heating. He has spent the last several years at Merit Mechanical in Tilden, NE.

any type of hunting with family or friends, and just relaxing with a beer.

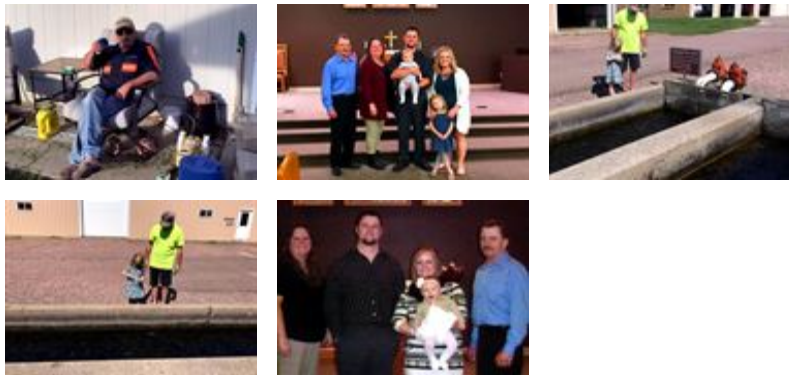
