NORFOLK -- Memorial service for Trevor J. Eisenbraun, 22, of Chadron, formerly of Norfolk, will be held at 10:30 a.m., Saturday, October 5, 2024 at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Norfolk. Pastor Lee Weander will be officiating the service. Inurnment will be held at the St. John's Lutheran Cemetery, rural Pierce. Visitation will be 4:00-7:00 p.m., Friday, at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Trevor passed away on Saturday, September 21, 2024 in Chadron, NE. Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements.

Trevor was born on July 31st, 2002 to Dwight and Christi (Koehler) Eisenbraun. He attended Bel Air Elementary School in Norfolk before attending Norfolk High School where he graduated in 2021. He was currently a senior at Chadron State College. Trevor was very active in many different organizations. He belonged to Our Savior Lutheran Church in Norfolk, Chadron State Campus Activities Board, Society of Range Management, Wildlife Club, Student Senate and ran cross country at Chadron State College and Norfolk High. Trevor was an Eagle Scout with Boy Scout Troop 122 in Norfolk and was assisting Troop 216 in Alliance, NE.

Trevor was attending Chadron State College for Rangeland Management and was planning on becoming a wildland firefighter. He had spent the last several summers working on the Payette National Forest in Idaho. Trevor enjoyed hiking, hunting, running, biking, time on the farm, and, really, anything

outdoors. He also enjoyed spending time with his family, friends, classmates and teammates.

Trevor is survived by his parents Dwight and Christi Eisenbraun of Norfolk, brother Andrew Eisenbraun of Lincoln, sister Erin Eisenbraun of Norfolk, paternal grandparents Julius and Christina Eisenbraun of Yankton, SD and maternal grandmother Faye Koehler of Pierce, NE and numerous aunts, uncles and cousins.

He is preceded in death by his maternal grandfather Galen Koehler.
