



## Verada M. Planer

August 11, 1922 - June 1, 2018

HADAR -- Funeral service for Verada M. Planer, 95, of Hadar will be held at 10:30 a.m., Wednesday, June 6, 2018 at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Hadar with Rev. Austin M. Ziche officiating. Interment will be in the parish cemetery, rural Hadar. Visitation will be 4:00-7:00 p.m., Tuesday, June 5 at the Stonacek Memorial Chapel in Pierce. Verada died Friday, June 1, 2018 at the Faith Regional Hospital in Norfolk. Stonacek Memorial Chapel in Pierce is in charge of the arrangements.

Born Aug. 11, 1922, in Pierce, she was the daughter of August and Martha (Spreeman) Droscher.

She was baptized on Sept. 10, 1922, and confirmed on March 17, 1936, at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Hadar. She attended country school at District 76 in Pierce County, and then attended Immanuel Lutheran School in Hadar to the eighth grade.

She married David Planer on Aug. 15, 1948, at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Hadar. They lived on a farm two miles north of the Hadar spur for the first seven years of their marriage, where David operated a gas station and garage in addition to farming. Two daughters were born to this union, Denise and Lynette; a son died in infancy.

In 1955, they moved to the home farm 10 miles north of Norfolk and continued farming there until they had a farm sale and retired in 2004. Following their retirement, they moved to their present home north of Norfolk. David died in 2011.

Verada was an active farmwife, doing anything from milking cows to driving the tractor. She enjoyed hand crafts, puzzle books, being a seamstress and going out to eat with friends and family. She was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Hadar and the church ladies aid.

Survivors include two daughters, Denise (Alton) Streich of Osmond and Lynette Pavlik of Norfolk; four grandchildren, Chad (Anne) Streich of Lincoln, Kyle (Sarah) Streich of Norfolk, Gina Streich of Osmond and Eric (Megan) Pavlik of Lincoln; five great-grandchildren, Zachary, Taylor, Carlie, Drew and Lily Streich; and many nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.

She was preceded in death by her spouse, David Planer in 2011; her parents; a son in infancy; two brothers, Elmer Droescher and Milton Droescher; and a son-in-law, Jim Pavlik.

Organist for the funeral will be Amy Bretschneider with congregational hymns "What God Ordains Is Always Good," "Precious Lord Take My Hand" and "For Me to Live is Jesus."
