WAUSA — Services for Verna A. Blunck, 89, of Plainview will be Monday at 10:30 a.m. at Golgotha Lutheran Church in rural Wausa. Interment will be in the Osmond City Cemetery in Osmond. Stonacek Memorial Chapel in Osmond is in charge of arrangements. Verna Ardith Blunck was born to Louis and Marie (Hoffart) Weber on June 9, 1925, at rural Plainview. She was baptized at Our Savior Lutheran Church in rural Plainview and confirmed at Golgotha Lutheran Church in rural Wausa. She attended country school through the eighth grade in rural Plainview and graduated from Plainview High School in 1942. After high school, Verna worked in many area homes taking care of household chores when there was a new baby in the home. On March 7, 1949, Verna married Elwood Blunck at the Pierce County Courthouse. They have two children, Karen and Randy. The couple farmed north of Breslau until 1957 when the family moved to a farm southwest of Wausa. In 1996, Verna and Elwood retired to their home in Osmond, and in November 2014, Verna moved to Plainview. The Golgotha Lutheran Women's Missionary League and her church were very important to Verna. She loved to visit, helped on the farm by milking, gardening and raising chickens for other people. Verna is survived by her two children, Karen (Gary) Larsen of Viborg S.D., and Randy (Julie) Blunck, Yankton, S.D.; grandchildren Jessica (Sean) Gallup and Amy

Larsen (fiancé Scott Pederson); two great grandchildren, Madeline and Finn Gallup; one sister Mary Lou (Dale) Carlson of Plainview and one brother John (June) Weber of Plainview. She was preceded in death by her husband of 65 years, Elwood, who died Oct. 2, 2014; her parents Louis and Marie Weber, three sisters; Helen Albin Kotrous, Gertrude Krause and Florene Holland Morrow.
