PIERCE -- Verne E. Voss, 76, of Pierce died Tuesday, May 7, 2013, at the Madison House in Norfolk. Services will be at 10:30 a.m. Saturday at St. John's Lutheran Church at Pierce with visitation starting at 9 a.m. and burial at the Laurel Cemetery. The Rev. Keith Christiansen will officiate with military rites by American Legion Post 72 and Offutt Air Force Base Honors Guard. Stonacek Memorial Chapel is in charge of arrangements. He was born Nov. 12, 1936, at Ponca to Eldo and Nellie (Sherman) Voss. He attended grade school at Lone Tree in Ponca and Wakefield High School. He graduated from Commercial Extension Business College in Omaha. He was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church of rural Pierce and American Legion at Pierce. After high school, he was a decoder in the military in New Foundland and Canada during the Cuban crisis. Verne then lived in York for a short time and later lived in Wakefield with his mother until 1971. He moved to Pierce where he did accounting work and also farm labor for farmers in the area. He entered the U.S. Air Force Nov. 17, 1958, and was discharged Nov. 16, 1962. Survivors include his siblings, Ben and wife Diane Voss of Omaha, Pat Turner of California and Gene and wife Judy Voss of New Hampton, Iowa; nieces and nephews, Stephanie and Kerri Voss, Kim and husband Earl Kuennen and Kelly Spier. He was preceded in death by his parents, Eldo and Nellie Voss, and brother Robert Voss. Organist will be Jean Zautke.
