



## Victor E. Rosendahl

July 6, 1932 - March 25, 2016

NORFOLK — Services for Victor E. Rosendahl, 83, of Norfolk will be at 10:30 a.m. Tuesday at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Pastor Clark Jenkinson will officiate with interment at the Spring Branch Cemetery, rural Norfolk. Military rites will be conducted by the U.S. Air Force Honor Guard, American Legion Post 16 and Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1644.

Visitation was 5-7 p.m. Monday at the chapel.

He died Friday, March 25, 2016, at the Norfolk Veterans Home.

Victor Rosendahl was born July 6, 1932, at North Platte, the son of Helge and Ruth (Gosnell) Rosendahl.

He graduated from North Platte High School and took some college courses. After high school, Victor worked for the Pacific Railroad before serving in the United States Air Force, serving from Sept. 16, 1952 until Sept. 15, 1956. After the Air Force he lived near North Platte and continued working for the railroad.

He married Darlene Wells on June 4, 1977, at the Methodist Church in Hoskins. In 1980, Vic and Darlene moved to Columbus where he continued working for the railroad until retirement. They moved to Norfolk in 2008.

Throughout retirement, Vic enjoyed fishing, junking, watching western movies and shows, and reading western books. He was also a big Husker fan. Vic loved being with his family as often as he could and also enjoyed taking his grandchildren fishing.

Vic was a member of the VFW and past member of the First United Methodist

Church in Columbus.

He is survived by wife Darlene Rosendahl of Madison; daughter Alice and husband Kurt Brudigan of Norfolk; daughter Rose Jensen of Osmond; son Roger and wife Pam Wells of Randolph; son Dan Wells of Norfolk; 12 grandchildren; 18 great-grandchildren; one great-great-grandchild; and numerous nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by parents Helge and Ruth; son Ronnie Wells; daughter LouAnn Jensen; three sisters, Jenny, Betty and Georgianne; one brother, Eugene; and one great-granddaughter.

Recorded music at the funeral will be "How Great Thou Art," "Amazing Grace," "Old Rugged Cross" and "On Eagle's Wings."
