PIERCE — Services for Victor E. Toelle, 91, Pierce, will be at 10:30 a.m. Friday at Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce. Vicar Eric Obermann will officiate with burial in Prospect View Cemetery.

Visitation will be 4-7 p.m. Thursday at Stonacek Memorial Chapel in Pierce. He died Tuesday, June 30, 2015, at Pierce Manor in Pierce.

He was born Dec. 9, 1923, at West Point, the son of William and Louise (Kersten) Toelle. He was baptized on Dec. 30, 1923, and confirmed April 10, 1938, both at Immanuel Lutheran Church in rural Beemer. Vic grew up in Beemer and attended Immanuel Lutheran parochial school there.

He married Veronica Hunke on Jan. 9, 1946, at Immanuel Lutheran parsonage in rural Beemer. After their marriage, they lived in Beemer and farmed. They moved to Norfolk in 1961. Vic worked at Norfolk Regional Center from 1962 to 1964. The family moved to Pierce in 1964. Vic worked for Don Lenz Construction five years and the lumber yard in Pierce.

Vic and Veronica were custodians at Zion Lutheran Church and School for 28 years. Vic enjoyed woodworking, bowling, golf and playing softball. He has been a resident of Pierce Manor since January 2015. The couple were married 69 years and six months.

He was a member of Zion Lutheran Church of Pierce, where he was a past elder, church council and Pierce Community Golf Course.

Survivors include his wife, Veronica Toelle of Pierce; two sons, Mert and wife Sheryl Toelle of Pierce and Rodney and wife Betty Toelle of Lincoln; a

daughter, Marilyn and husband Kevin Reagan of Pierce; 10 grandchildren and 20 great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, William and Louise; one son, Larry; and four sisters, Leona Haase, Hattie Haase, Verne Haase and Viola Brown. Organist for the funeral will be Mrs. Marcia Luebbe, and the soloist will be Mrs. Margret Jenkins, singing "Lord's Prayer" and "Oh That The Lord Would Guide My Ways." Congregational hymns will be "Amazing Grace" and "My Faith Looks Up To Thee."

Pallbearers are Tim Toelle, Trevor Toelle, Chad Toelle, Matt Toelle, Philip McLaughlin and Darrell Wagner. Honorary pallbearers are his grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
