



Virgil D. "Yogi" Frazier

NORFOLK — Virgil D. “Yogi” Frazier, 80, of Norfolk passed away Thursday, March 12, 2015 at Heritage of Bel-Air Nursing Home in Norfolk. Memorial Service will be held at 10:30 a.m., Tuesday, March 17, 2015 at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Officiant will be Reverend Donna Goltry. Burial will be at Hillcrest Memorial Park Cemetery. Visitation will be from 4:00 – 7:00 p.m., Monday also at the funeral home.

Virgil was born on December 21, 1934 to Patrick Frazier and Dorothy Hursell in Winnebago, NE. Virgil was raised by his paternal grandparents. He attended Center High School and after graduation he worked as a laborer building the Yankton Dam. On January 2, 1958, Virgil was united in marriage to Sharon Fry in Yankton, S.D., while serving in the United States Army. He was soon sent to serve in Korea. He received his honorable discharge from the Army in 1959. Virgil served from July 17, 1957 to August 4, 1959. Virgil and Sharon lived in Bloomfield, NE until they moved to Norfolk in 1962 to raise their two daughters Debbie and Donna. Virgil worked construction for Beckenhauer Construction and then the JH Hespe Construction in Norfolk for 31 years until retiring in 2000.

He was a member of First United Methodist Church in Norfolk and a lifetime member of the American Legion. Virgil’s favorite pastime was camping and boating with his family. His greatest joy in life was his grandchildren and attending their numerous and varied activities, along with polkas and his cowboy hats.

Virgil is survived by his two daughters, Debbie and husband Larry Schantz of Battle Creek, Donna Wolff of Norfolk, grandchildren Amanda Schantz of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, Jared Schantz and Adam Schantz of Battle Creek, Rachel Mann of Norfolk, brother-in-law Larry Fry of Farnam, NE, sister-in-laws Eileen Fry of Lincoln, Harriet Fry of Bloomfield, and step-sister Rebecca Frazier of Fremont, and numerous beloved nieces and nephews.

Virgil was preceded by his wife of 50 years, Sharon on April 21, 2008, his parents Patrick and Dorothy, grandparents, grandson Zebulun Wolff, one grandson-in-law, 6 brother-in-laws, 5 sister-in-laws, and one step-sister.
