



## Walter V. "Walt" Haase

Walt was born on November 30, 1938 in Cuming County, Nebraska to August and Leona (Toelle) Haase. He grew up in Cuming County and attended grade school at a country district school in rural Howells, he then attended Howells High School where he graduated in 1957. After his education he farmed and married Dianne Hilkemann on September 18, 1966 at Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce, NE. Walter and Dianne moved to Norfolk in 1968 where he worked for Bleyhl Construction for 12 years, Norfolk Grain and Dale Remmich for 12 years, Beef America for 12 years, Petersen Ag for 12 years and Werner Construction for 3 years. Walt was a member of Mount Olive Lutheran Church, Norfolk, Church Elder, served various church board positions, Youth Group Leader at Mount Olive, and the Northeast Nebraska UNL Alumni Association. He was very instrumental in starting the Midwest Toy Farmers. He enjoyed woodworking, hunting, fishing, watching his grandchildren in all of

their activities and being able to play with his great-grandchildren. Family was very important to him; he had a big giving heart for his family and friends.

Walt is survived by his spouse Dianne Haase of Norfolk, children Kim (Freddie) Tso of Norfolk, Kyle Haase of Omaha, grandchildren; Torrance Tso, Felicia (Joseph) Mathis, Jordan Haase, Meelah Haase, 3 great-grandchildren, sister Esther (Dan) Javins of Kearney and nieces and nephews.
