The son of Fred A. and Ing (Nelson) Albrecht was born Sept. 9, 1920, on the family farm near Pierce. After Warren and Elnora married, they farmed southwest of Pierce. They retired from farming in 1978. Warren enjoyed hunting, fishing, woodworking and horses. He had been a resident of the Pierce Manor since January 2010. He was a member of Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce.
