They moved to Fremont in 1987. He was employed at Williams Machine and Tool Co. near Omaha until January 1995, when they moved back to Norfolk. There, he was employed at the YMCA in Norfolk from 1995 until 2011. He was a member of Our Savior Lutheran Church in Norfolk.
