Memorials are directed to Immanuel Lutheran Church and School in Hadar. 1920-2017. Born Oct. 3, 1920, in Hadar, she was the daughter of Ezra Emil and Marie Corrine (Braeuer) Brisso. She was baptized on Oct. 4, 1920, at her family's home in Hadar by her grandfather, the Rev. Theodor Braeuer. She was confirmed on April 14, 1935, at Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce. She grew up in Pierce. The family moved back to Hadar in 1935. She attended parochial school at Zion Lutheran School in Pierce and Pierce High School in 1939. She married Gus Wagner on June 26, 1942, at Hadar. They lived a short time in Texas and Oklahoma. They moved back to Hadar in 1946. Gus worked in Hadar as a mechanic. They later started Wagner Repair in Hadar and ran the business for over 50 years. Gus passed away April 24, 2004. She was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Hadar, its ladies aid, Homemakers Club and the election board. Survivors include her children, Larry (Marilyn) Wagner of Scottsbluff, JoAnn Wagner of Lincoln, Wendy (Rev. Michael) Feuerstahler of Brown Deer, Wis.; nine grandchildren; eight great-grandchildren; and a brother, Spencer Brisso of Springfield, Ore. She was preceded in death by her parents, Ezra and Marie; two sisters, Bernice Williams and Maxine Brisso; and two brothers,
